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Practicing the Thematic Units in the Senior High School Japanese Classroom II

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This paper aims to (1) research several kinds of High school Japanese I textbooks and point out problems to be solved, (2) show an outline and characteristics of a curriculum built in 1999 which contains one or two materials in each unit from the textbook Japanese I, (3) examine the practice of the Unit: Recognizing language and recognizing by language, as a sample unit in the curriculum, and indicate results and problems, and (4) examine of all units in a new thematic curriculum for Japanese I mentioned above, through practices, and showed the results and problems. Students who learn Japanese through the 5 new thematic units showed interests especially in learning of the Unit: Self, and Human being. The new thematic units helped many students to think and live independently. But there are some problems to be solved: (1) we should prepare the well-balanced curriculum based on the major 5 themes, (2) establish a sequential arrangement of the materials of the Japanese I textbook, and (3) examine deliberately the quality of the all materials in the textbook before each new school year.

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
